# MEDIA GUIDELINES

### - OPERATION

#### Rules of thumb:

- · Always test videos for scaling on the screens and sound prior to the service
- · Check the arrangements of songs during the run-through to ensure accuracy of spelling and placement
- · Check slides against the sermon outline prior to the service and ask the speaker if you have any questions
- · Advance slides a few words earlier than the last word of the last slide to allow time for the transition
- · Lean on the side of too soon rather than too late for cuing slides or videos
- · Click on the clear slides icon at the top right if you get lost during a song until you find the correct slide
- · Go to a blank sermon slide if you are unsure of your place during a sermon
- · Clear the media on the Video Mac after each video is finished playing

### - NEW PLAYLIST -

- 1. Import videos and sermon slides
  - See "Importing"
- 2. Click the plus sign in the playlist window
- 3. Select "Planning Center Service"
- 4. Click the dropdown arrow beside Weekend Service
- 5. Select the correct date (should be at the top)
- 6. Check that matched documents are accurate, unlink if match is incorrect
- 7. Replace placeholders with appropriate documents
  - Type file name in the search window
  - · Click and drag to placeholder
- 8. Right click the playlist in the playlist window
  - · Click "Convert to Standard Playlist"
  - · This allows you to make further changes
- 9. Search and add "Motion" before each song set
- 10. Add the stage and timer actions to the first sermon slide
  - See "Stage Display" and "Timer Actions"

\*Note: Only import videos on Video Mac and leave videos out of playlist on Media Mac

## —TIMER ACTIONS—

Add timer action to sermon start:

- · Right click on slide
- · Add Action Timer Sermon Countdown
- · Make Sure "Set Configuration" is checked
- Make Sure "Countdown" is selected from the dropdown menu in set configuration options
- Enter the duration specified in the service order
- · Enable "Allows Overrun"

Click on the stopwatch below the output window to create or edit timers

## — S H O R T C U T S —

Clear Slide: F2 Clear Audio: F5

Enable Stage Display: Command + 2
Messages: Control + M
Split text to new slide: Option + Return

# - IMPORTING -

#### Videos:

- 1. In Finder, go to Living Hope Alliance Church/Files/ Videos/Finals/Year/Date
- 2. Drag and drop into the "Videos" Folder of the Media Bin
- 3. Right click video Playback Stop
- 4. Right click Scaling Scale to Fit

### Images:

1. Drag and drop files into the "Pictures" folder of the Media Bin

#### PowerPoint:

- 2. File Import PowerPoint
- 3. File will be under Living Hope Alliance Church/ Files/PowerPoint/Finals/Year/Date

## - STAGE DISPLAY

To enable stage display:

· Command + 2

or

· Screens - Stage - Enable

Adding stage actions:

- 1. Right click on slide
- 2. Add Action Stage
- 3. Select the desired layout from the dropdown
- 4. Slide destination should not normally be changed
  - An example for using this feature would be during a prelude song where the band needs the confidence monitor lyrics, but we don't want the lyrics appearing on the main screens

### Typical Stage Action Settings:

- · Sermon Sermon Lavout
- Motion Lyric Layout (stage + audience)
- Prelude Lyric Layout (stage only)
- Welcome Lyric Layout (stage + audience)

<sup>\*</sup> Duplicate the sermon title slide for the sermon end slide & to have a blank slide available.

# MEDIA GUIDELINES

## — NEW SONG —

- 1. Click [Search] in the toolbar
- 2. Click the Song Select icon (circles)
- 3. Enter the song title in search panel
- 4. Select the appropriate song (check the lyrics that pop up when you click on a song title)
- 5. Click "Import"
  - · Line Break
  - · 2 delimiters per slide
  - · 1280 x 720
  - · Song
  - · Theme: Default
- 6. Click "Import"
- 7. Edit lyrics as needed using [Reflow]
  - · 2 lines per slide
- 8. Ensure that each slide is labeled correctly
  - · Right click slide Group Label

# - CCLIINFO -

### For each song:

- 1. Click [Edit] in the toolbar (once song is selected)
- 2. In the "Copyright" section of the "Presentation" tab on the left, ensure that the Display Copyright box is checked
- 3. Ensure that the following categories are populated:
  - Title
  - Author
  - Publisher
  - · CCLI#
  - Copyright Year
- 4. If any of the information is missing:
  - · Go to songselect.com
  - · Search the song title
  - · Click on the song title
  - All information is available either at the top or bottom of the page, along with a lyrics preview to check the version of the song
  - · Enter missing information
- 5. Delete any "admin by" information in the publisher field

### - ARRANGEMENTS

- 1. Click the arrangement icon (three squares with arrows in song title bar)
  - Select the appropriate arrangement or create a new one
  - PCO arrangements are default arrangements, do not adjust these arrangements
  - Use arrangements matching worship leader when differing from the PCO default
- 2. Drag and drop sections into the arrangement

# MESSAGES

To display a child # or the grade 5/6 dismissal message:

- 1. Click on the paper airplane icon under the output window
- 2. Select the appropriate message from the list
- 3. Enter the correct number/info (if applicable)
- 4. Click "Show"
- 5. Click "Hide" to clear

# THEMES -

If a document size is mismatched, the "!" symbol will appear on the left side of the document in the playlist. To fix this:

- 1. Click the "!" symbol
- 2. Choose 1280x720
- 3. Select all the slides (command + a)
  - · Slides are outlined in blue when selected
- 4. [Theme] Default

Other themes are found here for specific uses

## 

To bring in a scripture reference:

- 1. Click [Bible] in the toolbar
- 2. Enter the scripture reference
- 3. Select slides and copy
- 4. Paste into document and edit breakpoints (4 5 lines per slide)

### - POWERPOINT -

When speakers want to control their own PowerPoint or have a PowerPoint with transitions/animations, run PowerPoint off of the Video Mac.

- In PowerPoint, click start slideshow from beginning
- Presenter uses up and down arrows on remote to advance slides

### - TROUBLESHOOTING **-**

If the slides are frozen on the screen:

- Check the preview screen for symbol of a crossed out eye and "Stage Only"
- · Click the eye to enable the main screen output

#### If computer is running slow

- · Check if OneDrive is syncing files
  - i. Click the cloud icon in the mac toolbar (top right)
  - ii. Click "Help & Settings"
  - iii.Select Pause Syncing 8 hours
