MISSION

The mission of Living Hope is to become what Jesus envisions by living out the grace and truth of Jesus Christ. We contribute to this mission by creating environments where people are encouraged to encounter God and are inspired to follow Christ's example.

VISION

To foster environments and experiences that are so inspiring and engaging that our church can't help but encounter God and worship Him with abandon. Our hope is that these experiences will inspire our congregation to worship God in everything they do; up, in, and out.

WHO WE ARE

We are a community of Christ followers who seek to glorify God by using our spiritual gifts and talents, pursuing our created purpose to live a life of worship for God. We have been transformed by the grace and truth of Jesus Christ and wish to offer ourselves as living sacrifices to God for all He is, all He has done, and all He will do. We are ordinary people with an extraordinary responsibility: to lead by example what it means to worship God 24/7 both inside and outside of the church walls. We do this by using our gifts and striving to live out the grace and truth of Jesus Christ so that others may be encouraged to do the same.

VALUES

Community: If we are to lead a community in worship, then we must first be a community of worshipers. We

grow deeper in faith, holiness, and humility in community. We strongly encourage everyone to

join a community group and to be open and authentic.

Surrender: Romans 12:1 says that our spiritual worship is surrendering to God as a living sacrifice.

Apart from God we are weak, but with Him all things are possible (Matthew 19:26). When we surrender wholly unto God, we allow Christ in us to take over and use us in amazing ways. This is

how we live a life of worship.

Abandon: God accepts us as we are; we need not worry about what our worship looks like to someone else.

Let us worship Him with abandon so that everyone can see our joy in Christ who saved us and

transformed us!

Devotion A surrendered life is passionately devoted to God; abiding in His presence and helping others do

the same. Let us approach our crafts with the same devotion and preparation.

Excellence: In light of all that God is, has done, and will do, how can our response be anything other than our

best? Excellence honours God and is a vehicle for participation.

Creativity: Our God is CREATOR! Our imagination and creativity reflects and glorifies our Creator.

Humility: God alone deserves all the glory and praise. If we are to boast, let it be in Him.

Humility is the hallmark of those who have a teachable spirit and who consistently strive to learn

so that they may serve God better.

WHATWEDO

We lead the community of Living Hope in worship through our gifts and talents in worship arts, including (but not limited to) music, sound, media, lighting, and video. We meet regularly as teams to develop our relationship with God and with each other so that we may be equipped and fueled to serve Him in the church, spurring each other on towards holiness and excellence in our areas of ministry. We also meet regularly to practice and prepare for weekend services and events. Together we develop our skills and abilities through regular practice, lessons, and workshops. We happen to have a lot of fun at the same time!

COMMITMENT

All worship team members commit to serve with their team for the duration of one ministry year (beginning in September). The following commitments pertain to roles related to weekend services:

- 1. Serving on a 4-week (once a month) rotation
- 2. One 2-hour rehearsal on Thursday prior to the scheduled weekend service (band, sound, media)
 - Thursday evening rehearsals run from 7:00 9:00 pm. Team members are expected to arrive early to set up any equipment for their own area so that we can begin promptly at 7:00.
- 3. Sunday Morning preparation:
 - Set-up of equipment/software related to role & sound check (8:00 8:15)
 - Production Meeting (8:15 8:30)
 - Run-Through (8:30 9:10)
 - Production Follow-Up (9:10-9:15)
 - Off Stage 9:20
 - Pray First 9:30
- 4. Consistent practice (musicians)
- 5. Quarterly worship ministry gatherings

The following commitments pertain to roles related to dramatic arts:

- 1. Weekly rehearsals on Wednesday evenings (7:00 9:00 pm)
- 2. Script memorization
- 3. Additional rehearsals/dress rehearsals approaching opening night
- 4. Assisting with promotion/awareness of show

All of the above commitments are mandatory as they are essential to our success and development.

EXPECTATIONS

Commitment: We are a team—everyone plays a vital role! Therefore, worship team members are expected to participate in all specified commitments. These commitments help us minister most effectively with excellence that honours God and encourages participation. Our commitment is to give ample (months in advance) notice of scheduled weekends, events, and workshops. In return, it is expected that team members will prioritize these in their calendars.

Missing any of the specified commitments doesn't just affect the individual, it affects the whole team and hinders our ability to achieve our mission and vision. For this reason, Thursday rehearsals are a requirement for serving on Sunday morning. Missing a rehearsal would require arranging a sub and not participating that weekend.

If you must miss any of the specified commitments, please advise your team leader at least 2 weeks prior to your scheduled weekend so that a replacement may be found. In extenuating circumstances where 2 weeks' notice is not possible, team members are expected to find their own replacement and inform their team leader of the switch.

Punctuality: Punctuality respects the time that we all invest in this ministry and maximizes our preparation time. It is expected that team members will be punctual to all call times.
