

<u>Living Hope Youth Summer Student Internship</u>

Full-Time

About the Position

The Summer Youth Ministry Intern will support the Youth Pastor in planning, coordinating, and executing programs and events for students in grades 6-12. This role provides an opportunity to gain hands-on experience in ministry, develop leadership skills, and foster spiritual growth in a dynamic church environment. The internship is a temporary position for 10 weeks during the summer, working 32 hours per week.

Reporting Structure

The intern will report directly to the Youth Pastor, who will provide guidance, feedback, and oversight throughout the internship.

Responsibilities

- **Program Support (40%):** Assist in running the summer ministry program including but not limited to games, off-site events, preparation of ministry space, etc. The ministry programming would include:
 - Wednesday evening youth nights
 - Tuesday and Thursday afternoon youth drop-in
 - Three offsite events throughout the internship
- **Event Coordination (40%)**: Assist in organizing summer ministry programming and activities to engage students in spiritual growth and community. Considering logistics for events such as running the event, chaperones, communication of events, supplies, booking, etc.
- **Discipleship (10%)**: Participate in discipleship opportunities with the Youth Pastor to grow spiritually and develop leadership skills and abilities.
- **Content Creation (10%)**: Develop engaging social media content for summer youth activities, as well as other content creation to promote things such as games, or events.



Qualifications

- **Age Requirement**: As this is a Canada Summer Student Job internship the applicant must be between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period.
- **Skills**: Strong communication, creative thinking, organizational skills, and ability to connect with teenagers.
- **Experience**: Prior experience in youth ministry, volunteering, or working with teens is a plus but not required.
- **Team Player**: Ability to work collaboratively with staff, volunteers, and parents.
- Background Check: Upon hiring, applicant must provide a criminal record check and adhere to church safety policies.

Time Commitment

- Duration: 10 weeks (June to August, flexible start/end dates).
- **Hours**: 32 hours per week, including evenings and weekends for events.
- Location: Living Hope Alliance Church, Regina, Saskatchewan, with occasional offsite events.

Compensation

- Hourly Rate: \$17/hr.
- **Professional Development**: Access to mentorship, training, and networking opportunities within the church.
